Those eligible to apply include any Rutland County high school senior who intends to pursue post-secondary education in any area **of television, film, radio, internet, computer animation, graphic and digital arts, sound engineering, photo and print journalism, marketing, communications, and public relations.**

COURCELLE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA & REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

1. Must be a high school senior in Rutland County
2. Be accepted as a student at a college, university, or trade school planning to major in one of the bolded fields above, while demonstrating involvement and a high level of proficiency in the visual or media arts
3. Submit acceptance letter from aforementioned school you plan to attend
4. Complete written application
5. Attach an essay of fewer than 500 words that describes why you are pursuing this field of study.
6. Include relevant samples of your work: ex. writing samples, photography, videos, marketing plan, etc.
7. Submit a transcript of high school grades
8. Dated letter of recommendation from at least one school administrator, teacher, coach, or community leader
9. Participate in an interview with the PEGTV Scholarship Committee
